




Did you know that at the Olde Canal Days festival, the Friends of the Canal Fulton Public Library (FOL) passed out: 355 FREE books, 32 FREE movies, 2 FREE books on CD, and 4 large full boxes of FREE magazines? This was in addition to 215 library newsletters, 28 library card applications, 49 FOL general information flyers, 69 FOL membership forms, and 233 bookmark coloring pages.
