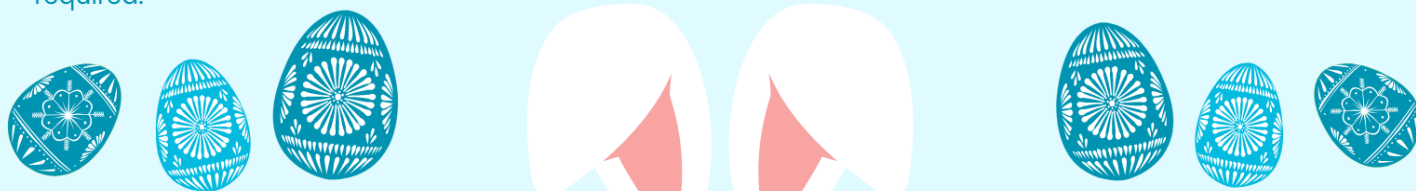

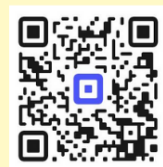
Grab and Go Mystery Crafts

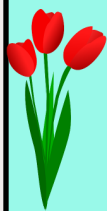

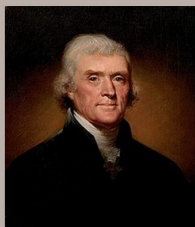


Happy Birthday, Thomas Jefferson!
