

Canal Fulton Public Library 3D Printer Policy

3D printers are available to staff and volunteers properly trained to make three-dimensional objects in plastic using a design that is uploaded from a computer file (.stl file).

Staff is available to print library patron requests at cost.

Patrons must have a Canal Fulton Public Library card.

To ask questions about 3D printing, please contact the Library at 330-854-4148.

- I. 3D printers may be used only for lawful purposes. No one will be permitted to use the Library's 3D printers to create material that is:
 - a. Prohibited by local, state or federal law.
 - b. Unsafe, harmful, dangerous or poses an immediate threat to the well-being of others.
 - c. Obscene or otherwise inappropriate for the library environment.
 - d. In violation of another's intellectual property rights. For example, the printer will not be used to reproduce material subject to copyright, patent or trademark protection.
- II. The library reserves the right to refuse any 3D print request.
- III. You will be notified of the cost before printing.
- IV. Only one print request may be made at a time. While staff can make recommendations of plastic filament type, we cannot guarantee the quality of your print.
- V. Users will be notified when their item will be printed and when it is complete.
- VI. Printing is available on a first come, first served basis and is done by library staff. Priority printing is given to library programs and events. Only designated staff and volunteers will have hands-on access to the 3D printer.
