During his career, Director Brown served as a librarian/ archivist (Roseville Public Library), an Assistant Head of Information Services (Fountaindale Public Library District), a Deputy Director/Assistant Director (Twinsburg Public Library and later Portage County District Library) and ultimately the Director of the Canal Fulton Public Library. (His ten year anniversary with CFPL will be on June 17th.)

Director Brown was passionate about the importance of local history and historic preservation and oversaw the completion of the program room library addition in 2020 and 2021. He also successfully guided the library through the COVID-19 pandemic, which was no small task! We will miss his leadership, dedication, historic knowledge, and most importantly his cheerful smile!
