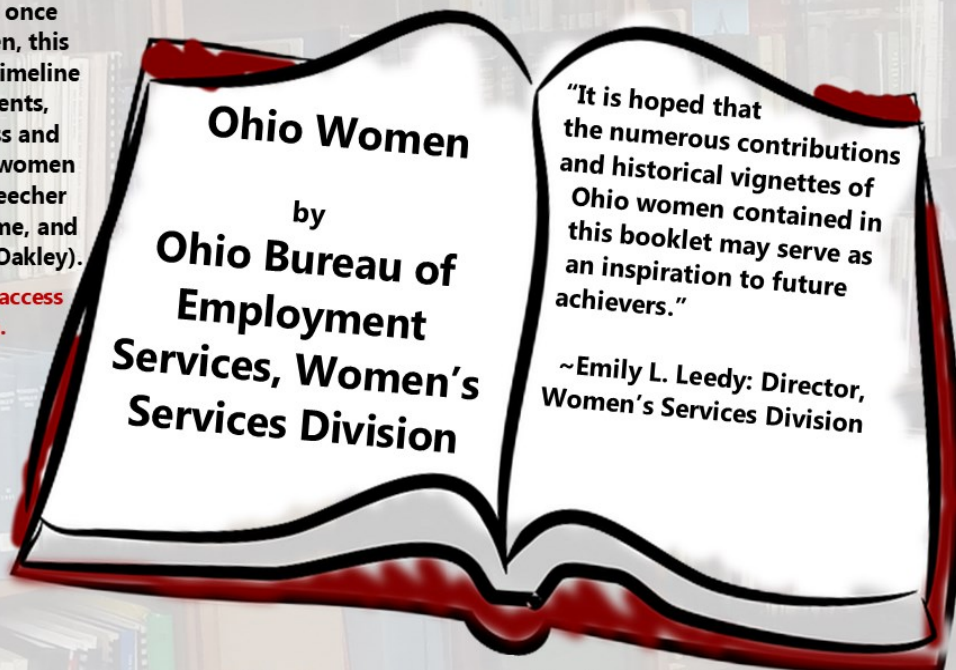
Spotlight On: New Books

2ND ANNUAL MINIATURE ART SHOW

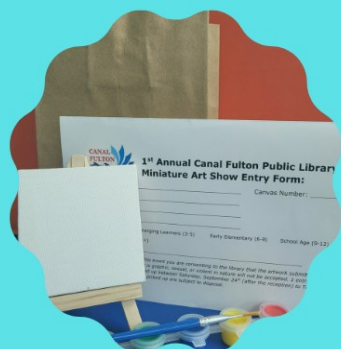
How it works:
