Board Meeting Information

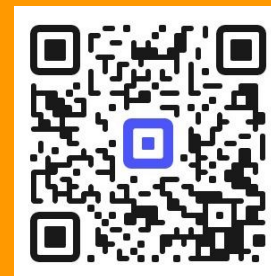
