Happy Little Snowflakes: Family Art Night

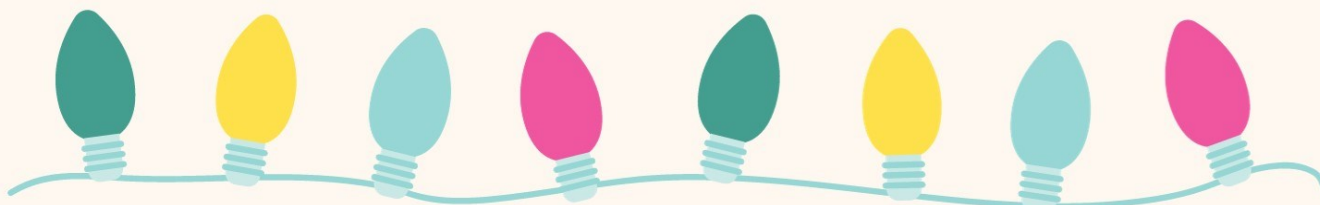
